
We are looking for dedicated and enthusiastic high school students to become a part of our museum.

The AMA Teen Council is a group of 10-20 high school students who represent teens at the museum

Members develop creative programming and coordinate community events

The Council meets for a weekend orientation. Then one Friday per month during the school year

What are the goals of the Teen Council?

Plan, support and promote teen initiatives at the AMA and within the community

Design and execute one project, targeted at teens that will be made available to the museum's audience at large

Attend and participate in lectures, group discussions, artist workshops and leadership training

Serve as volunteers assisting with museum classes, public events and community programs

Explore the professional roles and functions of various museum departments including: curatorial and design, marketing and public relations, membership management and finance and education and program planning.

We're looking for teens who:

Will be high school students during the 2016-2017 school year

Are interested in being a part of the AMA

Are highly motivated and passionate about developing community projects

Can commit to the weekend orientation, monthly meetings during the school year and assisting with occasional special events

The teens will gain:

A behind the scenes understanding of how museums operate

Foundational knowledge of art history, museum work, and creative careers through workshops, lectures and discussions with staff and artists






